CURRENT PROGRAMS

Education Program

Our education program has several components aiming to teach participants skills and build knowledge that improve health, enhance personal growth, and foster a supportive environment for our members.

- ₩ Book Club: Meet monthly to discuss carefully selected literature supporting personal growth
- Financial Literacy: build skills and knowledge to manage financial resources effectively
- ₩ Public Speaking: weekly Speak to Lead meetings for adults, and Speaking with Impact for youth
- W Mental Health & Family Relationship: learning sessions led by mental health professionals
- Special Speaker Series: learn from community and government leaders on important topics

Policy Advocacy

We actively involve community members and policymakers in championing academic-focused and merit-based education policies, striving to illuminate the rich tapestry of Asian American history within K-12 education curricula, dismantling biased education policies that disproportionately impact Asian American students, advocating for fairness and equal opportunities in the learning landscape. In our pursuit of educational equity, we leverage our collective voice to engage with policymakers, fostering an environment conducive to positive change. Additionally, we are committed to increasing Chinese Americans' participation in public elections, as voters, volunteers, and candidates.

Community Building

Committed to the vision of fostering a collaborative and supportive community, CAPA-NoVA stands at the forefront of building meaningful connections among Chinese Americans in Northern Virginia. Our mission extends beyond the boundaries of cultural differences, as we actively work to bridge any gaps between our community and the larger community, promoting mutual understanding and appreciation. At the heart of our efforts are the dedicated volunteers who have generously contributed thousands of hours to deliver impactful classes. These classes serve as a conduit for knowledge exchange and skill development, contributing to the enrichment of individuals within our community. CAPA-NoVA also actively engages in local community volunteering services. These initiatives not only strengthen our ties within the community but also reflect our commitment to being active contributors to the greater societal good.

FUTURE PROGRAMS

Community Support: We aim to offer complimentary assistance to our community members in various crucial areas, including immigration filing, home and car purchases, accounting, nutrition, fitness, therapy, alternative medicine, and more. This endeavor will be realized through strategic collaborations with local small businesses, creating a network of support services that cater to the diverse needs of our community.

Youth Education: We plan to establish a comprehensive program for K-12 students, rooted in classical traditions and encompassing essential elements such as humanity, history, aesthetics, virtues, and physical education. This holistic approach aims to serve as the foundation for education, fostering character development and providing valuable guidance for life planning.

Youth Internship & Employment: We will kick start a high school shadowing program and provide diverse internship opportunities across various industries. Additionally, we aim to facilitate career introductions and support individuals in pursuing certification exams for professional growth.

STORIES OF THE YEAR



On June 29, 2023, the U.S. Supreme Court struck down affirmative action in its landmark rulings on the lawsuits filed by Students for Fair Admissions (SFFA) against Harvard University and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC), rejecting the use of race as a factor in college admissions as a violation of the 14th Amendment's Equal Protection Clause.

For decades, race-based affirmative action implemented at Harvard and other selective colleges nationwide has caused tremendous harm to Asian Americans. Their admission criteria unfairly discriminated against Asian American students with a "racial penalty" – holding Asian American students to a selectively higher standard than other racial minority students. Now, the justices of the U.S. Supreme Court have finally provided equal protection of the laws to our communities.

CAPA NoVA partnered with the Asian American Coalition for Education (AACE) and organized a rally in front of the U.S. Supreme Court. AACE President Yukong Zhao delivered a passionate speech welcoming this historic ruling. Members of CAPA NoVA's core team and AACE leadership, joined by hundreds of supporters to celebrate this long-overdue victory.

A Vote for A Change



On October 6, 2023, CAPA NoVA hosted a debate for the candidates seeking the Dranesville District seat on the Fairfax County School Board: Republican-endorsed Paul Bartkowski and Democrat-endorsed Robyn Lady. CAPA NoVA's Alice Guo moderated this debate at the McLean Community Center.

CAPA NoVA and its members have been relentlessly advocating for merit-based education policies, unbiased treatment of Asian students, removal of political indoctrination from classrooms, and the elimination of politically charged school policies in our public school systems. This year marks the election for the Fairfax County School Board. Disappointed by the many harmful policies set by the current board, CAPA NoVA decided to provide its members and the public an opportunity to better understand the candidates' positions so that they could make well-informed decisions at the poll.

Over 200 people attended this event. The candidates engaged in a lively discussion on issues our community cares about. One of CAPA NoVA's missions is to encourage more Chinese Americans to vote in public elections so that our voices can be heard and our interests can be presented. We hope this event helped more Chinese Americans realize the importance of voting.

Youth Book Club

In 2023, CAPA-NoVA's Youth Book Club organized over 10 engaging book discussion sessions, led by dedicated student volunteers. They curated a diverse selection of thought-provoking books spanning

various genres, presenting our community with literary gems such as the philosophical journey of "Phaedo," the poignant narrative of "The Girl Who Smiled Beads," the inspiring tale of "Restart," and the enchanting wizardry of the timeless "Harry Potter" series, among others.

Our Youth Book Club aspires to cultivate a love for reading, instill critical thinking skills, nurture confident presentation abilities, and foster outspoken leadership qualities among the young minds in our community. Through these captivating book discussions, we aim to unlock the intellectual curiosity within each participant, encouraging them to explore different perspectives and broaden their horizons. Through the pages of compelling books, we continue to sow the seeds of knowledge, fostering a community of young readers who are not just consumers of literature but active participants in shaping a brighter and more enlightened future.

A Heritage Saved - China Folk House



On October 28, 2028, CAPA NoVA led 40 parents and students to volunteer at the China Folk House in Harpers Ferry, WV. The China Folk House was a farmhouse located in a rural village in Yunnan Province, China. It was beautifully built by local artisans following the traditional layout, materials, methods, and ornamentation of houses in the region going back centuries. To preserve this house, Dr. John Flower and Dr. Pamela Leonard

disassembled the house, transported all materials to the U.S., and rebuilt it in WV.

This event served as an educational opportunity for second-generation Chinese Americans to connect with their heritage. Students gained valuable insights into the historical context of the house, including its relocation from China. This event also provided a unique opportunity for participants to explore the distinctive features of ancient Chinese architectural structures.

The intersection of volunteerism, cultural education, and community engagement marked this occasion as a significant step in fostering a sense of responsibility and cultural awareness among the young participants.

Financial Literacy Series

In 2023, CAPA-NoVA unveiled the Weekly Financial Literacy Series—a thoughtfully curated program featuring a spectrum of seminars focused on financial planning and tax strategy. This series delves into topics such as family tax, retirement planning, college education, and small business tax savings.

Our mission is to empower both the younger generation and adults with essential knowledge in financial literacy, business acumen, and tax strategies. Through these seminars, participants gain invaluable insights into navigating the complex terrain of personal and professional finances. CAPA-NoVA is dedicated to creating a platform that fosters financial empowerment, nurturing a community well-versed in making informed financial decisions.
